At some jobs you can receive a bonus for certain work, or you might receive more money – a shift premium – for working shifts outside normal work hours. These payments would be in addition to your other form of pay (wage, salary, commission, etc.)

Ex. 1) You work in a bookstore selling books. You also sell customers reward cards for \$30.00 that will give customers a discount on future purchases. Your employer gives you a bonus of 10% of the amount received if you sell more than 20 cards in a month. If your regular wages are \$1883.77 and you sell 27 reward cards one month, what will your wages be including the bonus?

Ex. 2) You work as a waiter in a local café in Selkirk, MB. Yesterday you made \$165.32 in tips. If this was 15% of the bills you collected, how much were the bills?

Ex. 3) You work as a stock clerk for a grocery store in Moose Jaw, SK. Your regular pay is \$12.00 an hour, but you earn a shift premium of \$2.00 an hour for any hours you work between 5:00 pm and 8:00 am. You also earn 1.5 times your pay rate in overtime for any hours you work above 35 hours a week. Your timesheet is shown below.
