## SHIFT PREMIUM:

Ex. 1) You work in a bookstore selling books. You also sell customers reward cards for $\$ 30.00$ that will give customers a discount on future purchases. Your employer gives you a bonus of $10 \%$ of the amount received if you sell more than 20 cards in a month. If your regular wages are $\$ 1883.77$ and you sell 27 reward cards one month, what will your wages be including the bonus?

Ex. 2) You work as a waiter in a local café in Selkirk, MB. Yesterday you made $\$ 165.32$ in tips. If this was $15 \%$ of the bills you collected, how much were the bills?

Ex. 3) You work as a stock clerk for a grocery store in Moose Jaw, SK. Your regular pay is $\$ 12.00$ an hour, but you earn a shift premium of $\$ 2.00$ an hour for any hours you work between $5: 00 \mathrm{pm}$ and 8:00 am. You also earn 1.5 times your pay rate in overtime for any hours you work above 35 hours a week. Your timesheet is shown below.
